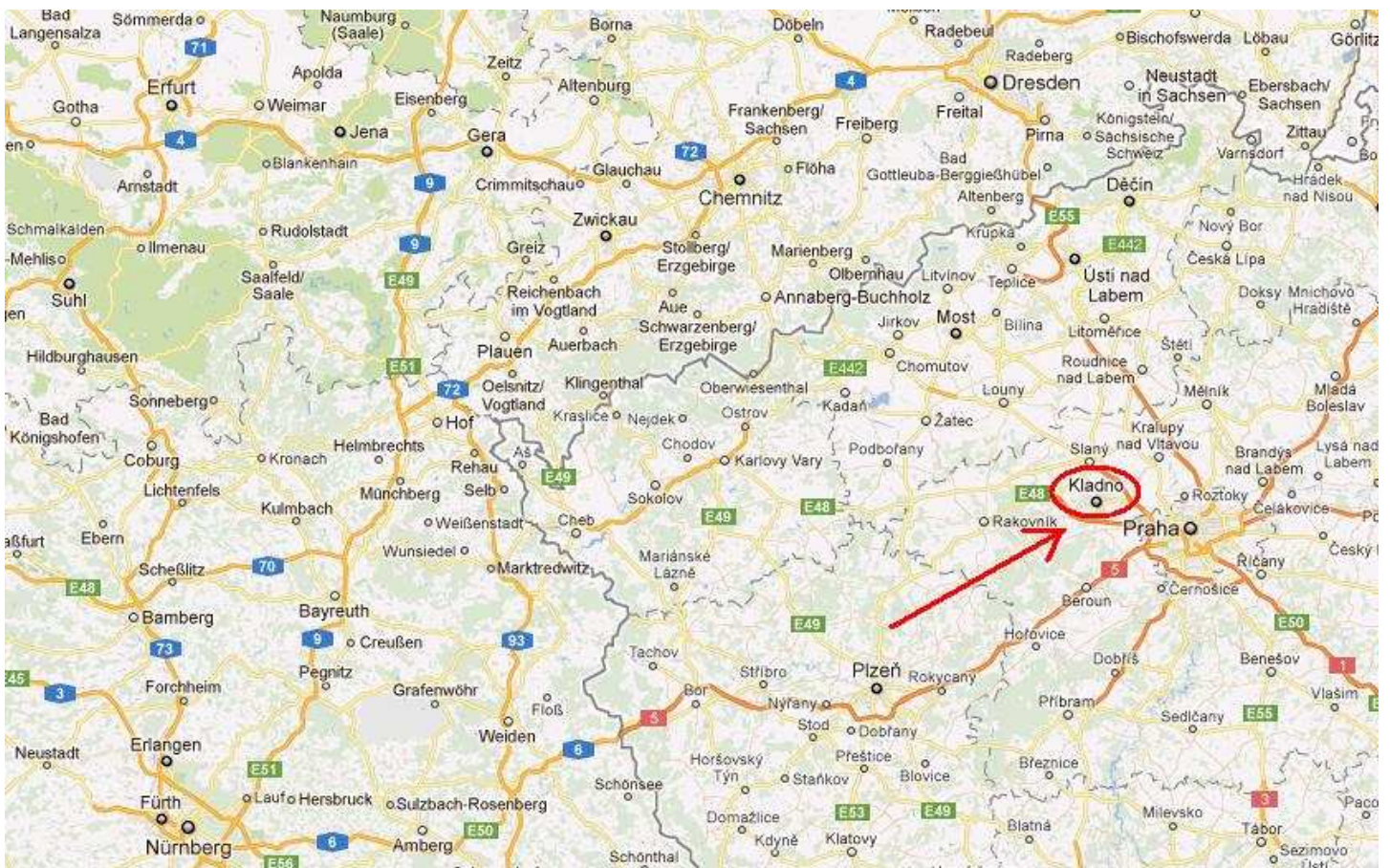
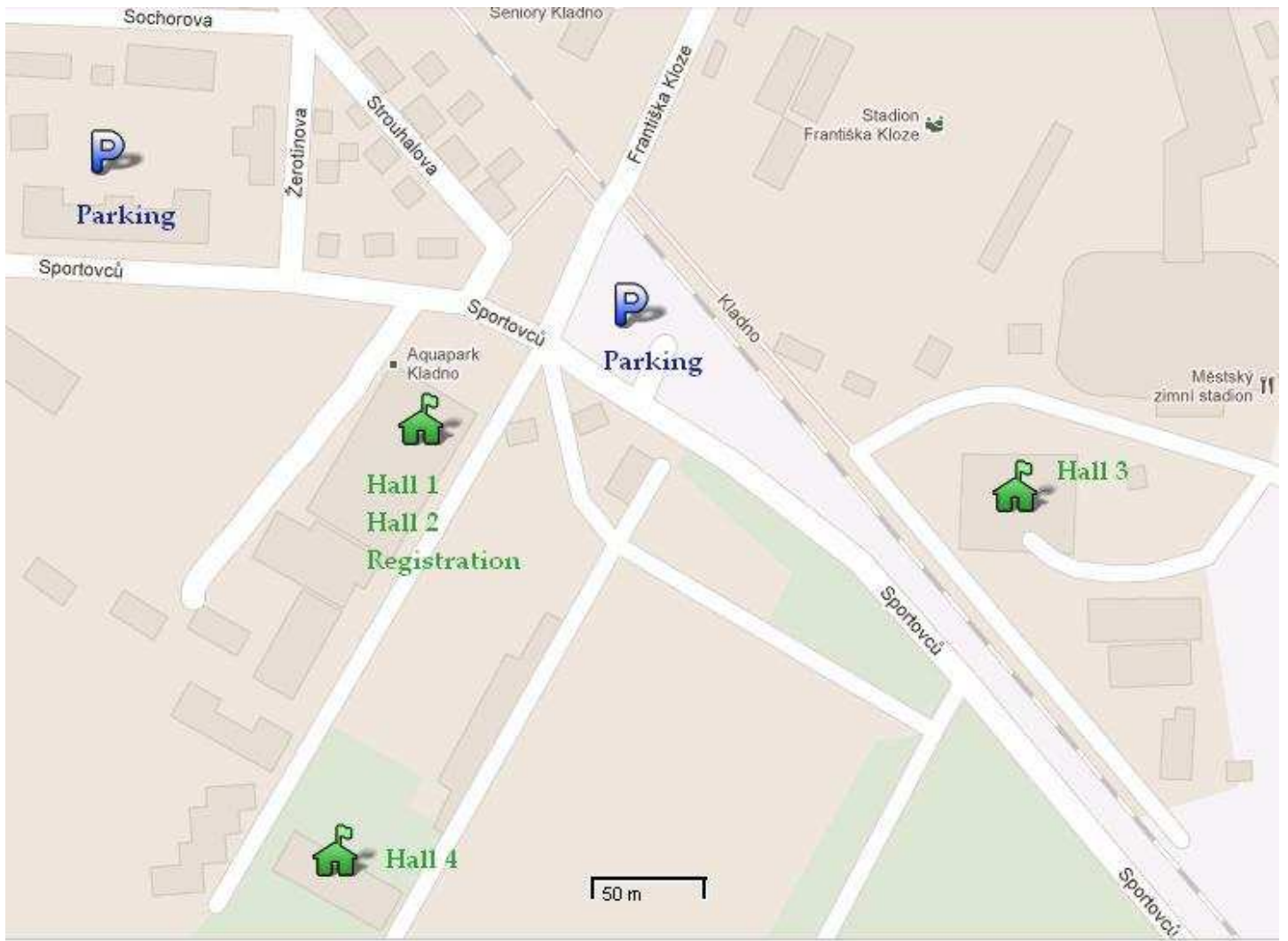

Information

- The European Convention 2012 will take place at the city sport site in the Sportovcu street in Kladno, Czech Republic. Halls 1 and 2 will be located in the same building together with the registration point and the Square Dance shops, halls 3 and 4 are in a walking distance from there. Parking places will be available nearby at two parking lots.
- As usual, there will be signs to lead the car drivers from the highway exits on.
- The entrance fee is **30 EUR** per person older than 26 years and **15 EUR** per person younger than 26 years. The fee covers the whole dance and it is not possible to offer part-time discounts. The fee includes the blue-and-yellow European Convention dangle.
- Although euro is not used in the Czech Republic, it will be accepted as the currency at the European Convention (along with Czech crowns, of course).
- One of the hall will be designated as the sleeping hall (for no extra fee) but remember that it has to be made ready for dancing on Saturday and Sunday morning.
- It is possible to stay in mobile homes at the parking lot but there is no electricity or water connection available. Sorry :-)
